Dear Friends of PLS,

Spring is beginning to blossom, and it is time to embark on planning for future events. One of the shelter's next major events is the design, development and plan to build two new buildings for future permanent housing for moms and children. You each have had a particularly important role in helping us to move toward this goal. The property we were fortunate to acquire in 2019, just south of the original property on Reagan Street, has been rezoned by the city at "Multi-use" on our street. This means we will be able to build "more" than we could when it was designated "commercial office." With this happening, our goal and objective is to complete our Precious Life campus with this project. Below is a picture of the two small houses that currently sit at 10901/05 Reagan Street. Envision two buildings, two/three stories that will include a meeting room equipment with to host board meetings, mentor socials, volunteer training and much more; counseling office; business offices and 6-8 new, two-bedroom units for graduates and their children; plus an outside gathering space for kids and moms to eat and play. Maybe even a few other design items the architect can add to enhance the lives of those you help as they work to change lives and that of their children.



Your support has gotten us to this particular stage of development, and we ask you to continue to help us meet our goals and objectives by your continued help. Our efforts are to use our fundraising events

and our annual pledge campaign, as well as foundation grants, to see this project to completion. We will keep you apprised of all that is happening as YOU are the ones who have provided the resources and prayers to get us to this goal.

Life here at PLS is busy with beautiful little ones bouncing in their seats, moms going to and from work, taking classes to enhance their life skills, finish their education, consider possible child reunification, and maintaining their own goals and objectives. We share with them this saying to encourage them everyday that they can do it. "Remember: Difficult Does Not Mean Impossible." Some of their past life situations are heart breaking, but we don't want them to ever think they can't dream a dream and strive to see it happen. You help is so important to those dreams.

Events are rolling so get that calendar out and join us for our Annual "Taste of Precious Life" on June 4th from 3-7pm at St. Isidore Plaza. Information in this newsletter and check our website.

Putting Cup will happen again this this year on August 5th at Big Rec Golf Course, a wonderful family morning. Set up that competition.

RESIDENT CORNER



"My name is Samantha. I am a 36 year old first time mother to my loving 6lb, 29 days premature baby boy, Walter III, aka Wally. I was homeless for almost a year and surviving was incredibly difficult and nearly impossible to escape. My life changed when I woke up in the hospital in the trauma unit to not only find out that I survived a vehicle hitting me at 40 miles an hour, leaving me with multiple broken bones, but that I also was going to be a mommy. I was already six months pregnant.

Baby Walter's father talked to Quality of Life Officer Rich Armond, who brought me safe and sound to the Precious Life Shelter. To my surprise, on March 27th I was having dinner and my water broke, and on March 28th, I gave birth to my healthy baby boy and my life would never be the same. My baby was 4 weeks premature and stayed in the NICU for eleven days while I traveled by bus everyday to see him until he could come home. My life now is so much more meaningful and precious. Our experience here at the shelter has exceeded all expectations that I had. This may be a "shelter," but this place is a home and it's our home.

We are expected to follow a structure, which helps to ensure our success here at Precious Life. We are offered so many different programs and classes, from cooking and sewing to emotional support and therapy, as well as case management, budgeting and parenting classes.

Surrounded by strong women, love, faith, laughter and encouragement, we are so grateful to be here. The generosity, all of the help, all the available programs, it's truly a blessing....an over the top blessing.

Precious Life holds the residents to a higher standard than we may have held ourselves, leading us to be responsible, hardworking, educated mothers. It's not always easy but it is the right way.

Thank you to the staff, volunteers and supporters for your time, dedication and resources, and thank you for letting me share my journey. If it wasn't for your program, I don't know where I would be. I am so incredibly blessed to share this bond with my baby and owe it to PLS for taking us in while we get back on our feet."

Eagle Scout Project by Anders Jew

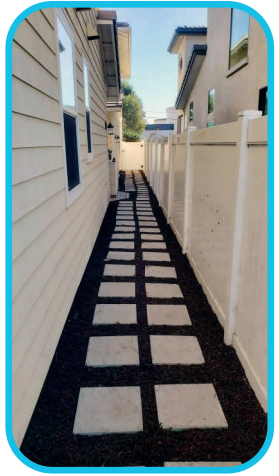
To create a safe walkway which connect both BBQ area and play yard located at Graduate Housing Unites on Cherry Street.

Anders and his hardworking crew created a beautiful pristine pathway between the two buildings at our graduates housing units on Cherry Street.
