been able to see so many of you in person? Although I must say that your outreach to help has been fantastic and such a blessing to those we serve. Healthy working women, healthy babies, wonderful staff, volunteers and supporters that regularly check in to see if we need anything special as they are going shopping, or donor would make a direct donation to carry us through financially.

Helen Keller wrote, "A bend in the road is not the end of the road....unless you fail to make the turn." This saying speaks perfectly to the uncertainty of 2020 which has caused great anxiety for many. And often the answers given do not quell such anxiety. We want you all to know that we have not "failed to make the turn" as we have adjusted our intake process, our housing procedures and care for residents, staff and volunteers, allowing us to navigate the road toward 2021. We ask you to help us make this end of the year one that helps us help our moms and children, and we are exceedingly grateful for your support and prayers.

We are planning our holiday season to enrich their lives to let them know they are well taken care of by those who care about them. As I have shared before, Thanksgiving and Christmas can be lonely for residents who do not have contact with any family, so we try to provide that wonderful family atmosphere for them through your generosity and goodness.

Our shop has been open since June 22, and we are busy, which is wonderful. If you are ready and comfortable to volunteer, we certainly need afternoon volunteers. Join us and know we have taken "masks required" and "social distancing", plus sanitizing, very seriously. Our donations continue to supply the shop with new items almost everyday. THANK YOU! But please do not leave donations when there is not someone at the shop to receive them, as we have had a tremendous theft problem. We have partnered very straight forwardly with the Los Alamitos Police Department, who have been terrific in helping to stop some of the more egregious stealing we caught on the surveillance cameras. Unfortunately, we are not allowed to have "visitors" or "gatherings," so we will not be able to have our annual "A Precious Christmas" Open House in December. Watch for events planned for outside, as we look to have some "fun" raising in 2021 to gather and support those we serve and who need our assistance.

As you each prepare to decide how you will celebrate with those you love, we thank you for standing with us and sharing willingly for those we serve. Our annual pledge campaign cards have been mailed; with the uncertainty of this year, we hope you are able to join the campaign to support Precious Life for this annual drive. Your support changes the lives of the women coming through our doors and allows them to believe life might be better for them in their future.

Certainly there will be obstacles, there will be doubters, there will be mistakes, but with hard work there are no limits to what can be accomplished with the support provided for those looking to give a good life to their child. We thank you for being the catalyst to ignite the possibility of success for each woman we serve.





Qualified Charitable Distribution: You can get a tax break without itemizing. QCD is a tax strategy that allows you to transfer up to \$100,000 per year from your IRA, counts toward your RMD, and reduces your taxable income.

Brokerage Charitable Gift Accounts: As a Charitable Gift Account (aka Donor Advise Fund), Holder, you can make grant recommendations to the charitable accounts at your brokerage firm.

Gift of Stok or Bonds: By making a gift of your appreciated securities, you can avoid paying capital gains tax that would otherwise be due if you sold these assets

\$300 Deduction of Cash Contributions: Ability for an above-the-line deduction of up to \$300 of ash contributions to charities, regardless of whether the individual itemizes deductions.
