Welcome to 2023, as we begin this year with two beautiful baby boys born just days after moms arrived at PLS! As we begin our 34th year of service to the vulnerable homeless pregnant woman, we still know that the services provided by your generosity are as needed as ever. Our mission remains steadfast to provide the most needed services we can to help the women walking through our doors. They are coming later and later in their pregnancies, services are further away, so they must travel just to get to doctors and hospitals their need for emotional as well as physical services sometimes is critical to the well being of mom and certainly her baby. We ask everyday how can we meet their needs, and then one of you calls or walks through our door and asks "How can I help?" We smile and realize that "Big journeys begin with small steps," and our women just need to be assured that we are here for them so their "Big Journey" can begin.

We are in the midst of creating our development and expansion plans to share with you this year, and also looking at how our services to our women and children can be updated to meet the changing needs from their time on the streets. We are asking you to consider being a mentor or instructor, maybe you would like to be a birth coach, or perhaps you are interested in volunteering at our Thrift Shop or on one of the event committees to support our efforts in "Saving babies, one mother at a time." Every volunteer provides such a valuable asset to our women and our program. Thinking back 34 years, I can remember being asked to help answer the phones on Tuesday morning, and just recently received a call from one of those moms who called 30 years ago. She shared her success and gratitude for Precious Life just being there for her and now grown child. You have accomplished so much for the over 3500 babies and moms that have walked through our door.




